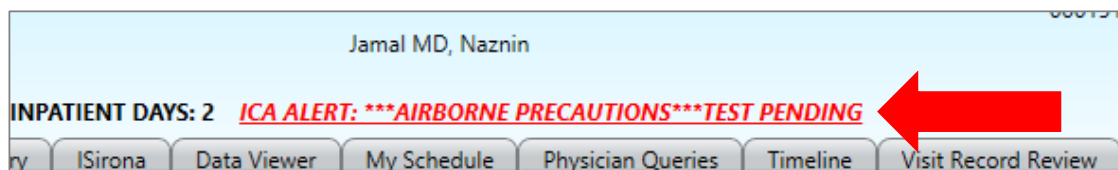
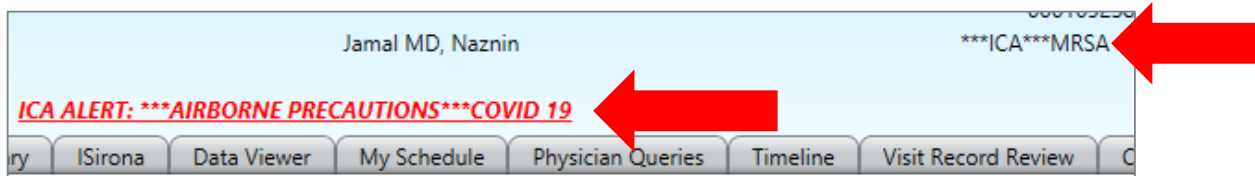


# Header Update

The Infection Control Department is updating the patients Header in Allscripts with information regarding isolation for positive and pending COVID-9 testing.

The following enhancements have been made:

- Positive and pending COVID 19 notifications have been moved down, placed in all caps, and red font to draw attention.
- The non-COVID infection control prevention notifications will remain where they always have been.





# Stool and Urine COVID19

Due to the fact that the COVID-19 virus is shed in the stool and urine you must use the following precautions when caring for Positive/ Suspected COVID-19 patients.

- Isolate patients in private rooms or cohort them in the same room using contact isolation precautions when entering the room.
- STRICT HAND HYGIENE WITH **SOAP AND WATER** MUST BE OBSERVED BY ALL HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL AND VISITORS ENTERING AND LEAVING THE ROOM.
- Wear gloves when entering the room.
- Wear a gown, when providing hands on pt. care or when there is anticipated contact with the patient environment. (ex: bathing, changing linens, cleaning pt room, turning pt, during head to toe assessment of pt).
- Change gloves after contact with material that may contain high concentrations of COVID-19. (feces, bedside commodes, etc.)
- Carefully remove gloves and gown before leaving the patients room and wash hands with **soap and water** immediately.
- Dedicate items to a single patient infected with COVID-19. Use disposable equipment when possible. (i.e., thermometer, stethoscope, blood pressure cuff, pillows, etc). Any equipment to be used on other patients MUST be cleaned and disinfected with a disinfectant containing bleach before continued use.
- Contain all linens in laundry bags in patient's room before transporting to soiled utility area. Linens must not be shared with other patients on the floor.
